Majors Fee	Fee paid by undergraduate students (\$125 per student) comes directly to the college and distributed between the Dean's office and units	Undergraduate operating expenses	By Request
E & T Fee	Fee that students pay for (E)ducation and (T)echnology – used at university level and then a portion is allocated for each college determined by Academic Affairs – distributed between the Dean's office and units	Must be used for expenses that directly (i.e. no travel) tie to the education of students and/or technology expenses	By Request
Trust (non-Endowed)	Gifts / contributions by donors	According to donor agreement	YES
Trust (Endowed)	Gifts / contributions over \$25K can be set up as an endowment that generates an annual spending distribution each year once performance is at a designated level.	According to donor agreement	YES
PI F&A / PI Overhead	In October, Faculty receive back 10% of their F&A ("indirects") receipts generated from external grants during the previous fiscal year up to \$5,000. If less than \$500, will be distributed to unit overhead.	Pl's research related expenses or overhead costs	YES
Unit F&A / Unit Overhead	Faculty member's unit/department receives an additional 10% of F&A receipts generated and any faculty members' F&A return if less than \$500.	Unit/department's research related expenses or overhead costs	YES
